### Key to transliteration

### Notes

- The writing direction is right-to-left.
- Mostly the transliteration is simply letter-for-letter, but
  - note the digraphs DJ, GB, KH and OU
  - that E and É are different.
- DJ and Z, GB and G, and K and KH form pairs, the second in each case being written as the first followed by a dot `.
- GÉ and GI are written GUÉ and GUI.
- the U is not transcribed.
- The syllabic nasal written as N' or M' depending on the following sound, has the same symbol ɳ.
